An attempted jetting of the blocked drainage pipe in High Haden Road was unsuccessful because it was discovered that the pipe was broken on the land of Fallowfields. The owners of the property contacted their insurance company NFU. However, after several months it has recently come to light that the insurance policy does not cover culverts. CS and AP will visit the owners of the property to ascertain what the next steps might be in helping them to resolve this issue.

The Council will investigate forming an action group to develop a flood action plan for the village.
